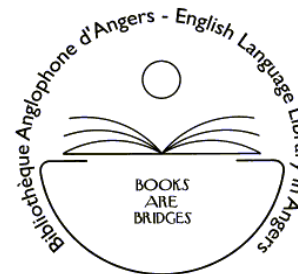

What is French in Action?

French in Action is a program that provides regular session of one-to-one conversational French for men and women for whom English is a first language and French is a second language. It is a fundraising program for both the English-language Library in Angers and the English-Speaking Union Loire Valley.

Who is in charge of the conversations?

The program is run by members of the English-language Library in Angers and the English-Speaking Union Loire Valley. These volunteers have wide interests and a good understanding of their heritage and culture. They are all native French speakers and are interested in promoting greater understanding between people of all countries.

When and where :

Conversation is wherever possible on a one-to-one basis. A topic is chosen for discussion and can be on any subject, ranging from day-to-day living to international politics. Discussions might include books, current newspaper articles, theater, shopping and other subjects of common interest. Those participating meet at the English-language Library unless otherwise arranged.
